Sub: Grant of Concessions to teachers-both senior and junior working in the Medical Colleges of the State and also doctors working in the periphery for attending conferences, seminars, workshops, examinership etc.
Sir/Madam,

I am directed to say that in this Department G.O. No. 15020/H., dated 18.04.92 certain concessions were granted to the teachers both senior and junior working in the Medical Colleges of the State and also doctors working in the periphery for attending conferences, seminars, workshops and examinership etc. Soon after issue of the said G.O. the OMTA made a representation for extending the concessions available for senior teachers to the junior teachers working in the 3 Medical Colleges. After careful consideration of the said representation Government have been pleased to modify the aforesaid G.O. to the following extent.

- (i) The concessions granted in para 2(i) of the aforesaid G.O. shall be extended to both the junior teachers (Lecturers) and doctors working in the periphery, who could produce papers as would be acceptable in the International Conferences, Workshops held outside India.
- (ii) The concessions granted in para 2(ii) of the aforesaid G.O. shall be extended to both the junior teachers (Lecturers) and doctors working in the periphery in respect of National Conferences, Workshops and Seminars held inside the country provided their papers are acceptable by the organizing agency. Seniority, however, will count only when there are more number of doctors of any rank whose papers have been accepted by the organizing agency. In such cases only the seniormost teacher/doctor working in the periphery shall be given concession.

2. This may be brought to the notice of all concerned.
