Sub: "Odisha State Treatment Fund"-Guidelines there of .

Sir,

"Odisha State Treatment Fund" is being made functional from 15th December, 2011 in order to provide financial assistance to poor patients suffering from life threatening diseases. Highlights of the scheme are enclosed. The details of operational guidelines of this scheme are available on our website, www.orissa.gov.in/health_portal, which may be downloaded forthwith & read carefully.

The assistance provided towards treatment of patients under Chief Minister Relief Fund hitherto will be covered under this scheme. All other non-treatment related issues will be dealt under CMRF as earlier. To facilitate transition, the existing procedure of CMRF will be followed till 31-12-11 so as to clear pending applications.

In order to make the scheme operational you are requested to take up the following measures immediately:

- 1) To appoint Nodal Officer in each clinical department / units as per provisions of guidelines and report compliance.
- 2) To appoint members of screening committee as per guidelines and report compliance.
- 3) To sensitize members of screening committee, Nodal Officers and HODs.
- 4) To open a joint passbook as prescribed in the guidelines immediately, so that money will be transmitted to your account for use as corpus fund. The account number and name of the bank be intimated to DMET(O) with a copy to the undersigned by **return fax**.
- 5) To print application forms and required registers immediately .
- 6) To take up IEC activities for awareness generation

In order to facilitate treatment of the poor patients of the State, the above instructions may be accorded top priority.



HIGH LIGHTS OF ODISHA STATE TREATMENT FUND

Who are eligible

The person admitted in Government Hospitals as in-patient provided he/she is a:-

- BPL Card holder
- Having annual income upto **Rs. 40,000 in Rural areas & Rs. 60,000 in Urban areas** (income certificate from concerned Tahasildar to be submitted)
- Referred cases from registered **Mental Asylum/ Destitute Home/ Orphanage**
- Unknown accident Victim

Who are not eligible

- Those suffering from diseases of common nature and disease for which treatment is available free of cost under other health programmes/schemes
- Those going for treatment in other than Government Hospitals (unless otherwise designated)
- Central Government/State Government/P.S.U employees
- Where Medical expenditure has already been incurred
- Where medical coverage under ESI, CGHS or any other scheme is available
- Repeat assistance for the same ailment in the same financial year

Assistance for what purpose

- Major illness as mentioned in guidelines or as considered appropriate by Screening Committee of the concerned Hospital
- Investigations

Quantum of Assistance

- Upto a maximum of Rs. 3,00,000/-
- Sanction upto **Rs. 50,000** at District Head Quarters Hospital (for sanction beyond Rs. 30,000 upto Rs. 50,000 with approval of Collector)
- Sanction upto **Rs. 1 lakh** at Capital Hospital, Bhubaneswar & RGH Rourkela
- Sanction upto **Rs. 2 lakh** at Government Medical Colleges (for sanction beyond Rs. 1 lakh upto 2 lakh with approval of RDC)
- Sanction between **2 lakh to 3 Lakh** at Government level
- Sanction for more than **3 lakh** with approval of Hon'ble Chief Minister, Odisha

Where to get

- **For all Government Hospitals in districts & DHH** - From District Head Quarters Hospital
- At Capital Hospital, Bhubaneswar & RGH Rourkela
- In all 3 Government Medical Colleges and Shishu Bhawan, Cuttack

How to get

- Indoor patient will apply to **concerned Health Institution** in prescribed application form along with copy of **BPL Card / Income Certificate / Referral Slip** from Secretary of registered **Mental Asylum/ Destitute Home/ Orphanage**
- On the day of admission patient will be paid **50% of the estimated cost of treatment** in shape of Cheque
- The balance amount will be paid on submission of **voucher during/ after treatment before discharge** from Hospital in shape of Cheque
- The patient will be paid as per the **actual expenditure** or the **ceiling limit prescribed for different disease** conditions under Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS), whichever is lesser.
