

GUIDELINES FOR ALLOTMENT OF CANDIDATES FOR POST-GRADUATE (MEDICAL) COURSES IN THE MEDICAL COLLEGES OF ODISHA FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2014-15

Consequent upon the decision of Govt to take candidates from the merit list of AIPGMEE- 14 for admission to MD/MS courses in the State Quota seats in the academic session 2014-15, the following guidelines are framed for allotment of candidates in different Govt Medical Colleges of the state and HITECH Medical College, Bhubaneswar.

The state of Odisha shall fill up the seats by way of counselling.

A. Counselling Committee & its function :-

One Counselling Committee is constituted consisting of

The Committee will frame the detail procedures for counselling and seat matrix with prior Govt. approval. The directions of the Hon'ble Apex Court and High Court in different WP(C)s or WAs must be kept in mind while preparing the draft of such procedures.

The Selection committee shall collect the detail State Quota seats for the academic year 2014-15 from the Principals of three Govt. Medical Colleges and Hi-Tech Medical College, Bhubaneswar and prepare the seat matrix for counselling.

The reservation percentage should be strictly adhered to while preparing such merit list.

The Committee will function in the office of the Dean & Principal, SCB Medical College, Cuttack, and will carry out the following works.

1. Collect the merit list of State from the National Board of Examinations.
2. Prepare the inter-se merit list of in-service candidates by awarding additional weightage of marks, as per the provisions contained in Clause-G. No additional weightage shall be given to Direct Category of candidates.

B. COMMENCEMENT OF SESSION :

The admission will be made once a year. The academic session commences from **1stMay 2014**, unless otherwise notified.

C. DURATION OF THE COURSE :

- 1) The Post-Graduate (Medical) courses usually are of 3 years duration from the date of commencement of the course i.e. **1stMay 2014** subject to joining of the candidate in the course. In case of any shortfall of three years of tenure, the candidate is to repeat the course for the shortfall period.
- 2) Candidates having recognized P.G. Diploma shall be exempted one year from the total duration of P.G. (Medical) Course provided they undergo P.G. (Medical) Course in the same subject.

D. DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS :

The available seats under state quota are to be distributed among in-service and direct candidates on 50:50 basis. In case of the total seat comes to an odd number the extra seat will be distributed between in-service and direct candidates on year to year rotation basis.

E. RESERVATION OF SEATS:

For in-service candidates the reservation percentage will be 72% for UR category, 12% for ST category, 8% for SC category, 3% for PH and 5 % for Green Card category. For direct candidates the reservation percentage will be 69% for UR category, 12% for ST category, 8% for SC category, 3% for PH and 5 % for Green Card category and 3% for Defence category.

Note 1: Schedules Caste/Scheduled Tribe persons who have migrated from their State of Origin to some other State for the purpose of seeking education, employment etc. Will be deemed to be scheduled Caste/Tribe of the State of their Origin and will get privilege from the State of origin and not from the State to which they have migrated. (Vide Govt. of India Letter No. BC/16014/1/82-SC&BCD/Dated: 22nd February 1985).

Note2:Seats reserved for S.T. and S.C. candidates are to be filled up by the applicants belonging to the community as per the Odisha Caste Certificate (for S.C. and S.T.) Rules-1980 and as amended from time to time by Government of Odisha.

Note3: Seats reserved for Children or Spouse of Service/Ex-service personnel (Defence) are to be filled up by such candidates under the Direct category only.

Note 4:Seats reserved for physically handicapped will be filled up by the candidate having locomotor disorders of lower limbs between 50% to 70%. Provided that in case any seat in this 3% Quota remain unfilled on account of unavailability of candidates then such unfilled seat/s shall be filled up by candidates with locomotor disability of lower limbs between 40% to 50% . If still they are unfilled then such unfilled seats will be included in the unreserved category. (vide Notification No-MCI-18(1)/2008-Med./54470 dt. 25.03.2009)

Note 6:Candidates claiming under Green Card category must produce the Green Card in original of their parents, and must not have taken the privilege of reservation using the same card before. The facts & figures mentioned in the Green Card must tally with other relevant certificates submitted. In case of any discrepancy the claim under Green card reservation will not be considered. However he will be treated under unreserved category.

F.CATEGORY OF CANDIDATES :

A candidate in order to be eligible for prosecuting P.G. course under State quota seat must be a permanent resident of Odisha.

1. A **Direct Candidate** is one who at the time of application:
 - a. Is son/daughter/ spouse of a person who has served in Defence Service in the state of Odisha for minimum of 5 years by **31st March 2014.**
 - b. Is either unemployed or in the regular employment of Government of Odisha/PSU, and not completed 3 years' service which includes all categories of employment like contractual/ temporary / ad-hoc/ regular by **31st March, 2014.**

Provided if the candidate has joined Govt. service on regular basis, he/she will be eligible for prosecuting super speciality course or engagement as SR/Tutor only after completion of 2 years of post PG service under the state Govt. which includes all categories of employment like contractual/ temporary / adhoc/ regular.

2. An **In-service** candidate is one who at the time of application:

Is in the regular employment in Government of Odisha/Govt. of Orissa Public Sector Undertakings/Govt. of India Public Sector Undertakings located in Odisha and has completed a length of 3 years of regular service including contractual, temporary, ad-hoc and has been duly selected by Govt./OPSC/PSU appointing authority, before **31st March, 2014** excluding at-a-stretch leave of any kind, of 30 days or more. However the maternity leave is exempted from this exclusion and shall be counted towards the length of three years of service.

G. ADDITIONAL WEIGHTAGE:

The additional weightage will be awarded only to those regular in-service candidates (mentioned at F-2 Supra) who are in employment in Govt. of Odisha/ Govt of Odisha undertaking/ Govt. of India Undertaking and have qualified in the Entrance Examination and have worked in Rural/Tribal/Backward areas (as per the list annexed) and the candidates shall be awarded an additional weightage of 10% of the marks secured in the P.G. Entrance Examination per year of completion of service in above areas, subject to maximum of 30% of marks secured in entrance examination.

H. ALLOTMENT OF SEATS:

1. Candidates shall be allotted in order of merit from each category for admission by Counselling (Online or personal appearance) and the order of Counselling shall be ST (in-service), SC (in service), PH (in-service), Green Card (in-service), Common (in-service), ST(Direct), SC(Direct), PH(Direct), Children for Service/Ex-service Personnel (Direct), Green Card(Direct), Common (Direct) candidates.
2. In case of non-availability of eligible ST(in-service) candidates, the unfilled Seats of their quota will be merged with SC (In-service) seats and the total seats thus derived shall be filled – up by SC (In-service) candidates.

3. The unfilled SC (in-service) seats if any shall be merged with the In-Service (Common list). In case of non-availability of candidates in In-Service (Common) category, the seats will merge with Direct Category, in the respective reserve category.
4. In case of non-availability of ST (Direct) candidates, the unfilled seats will be merged with SC (Direct) seats and the total seats thus derived shall be filled up by SC (Direct) candidates. In case of non-availability of seats in SC category the seats will merge in Direct Common category.
5. If eligible physically handicapped candidates (in-service) are not available, the seats shall be filled up by in-service common category. If PH in-service candidates are not available it will merge in PH (direct) and if still remain unfilled it will merge in Common (Direct) category.
6. If eligible candidates under quota of Children/Spouse of Service/Ex-service personnel are not available, the seats shall be filled up by Common (Direct) candidates.
7. In-case of non-availability of in-service Green Card candidates, the seats will be merged in the in-service Common category. If still remain unfilled it will merge in Green Card (direct). If still remain unfilled, it will merge in Common (direct) category.
8. In case of non-availability of candidates against Unreserved (in-service) seats, the seats will be filled up by Unreserved (Direct) candidates.

I. ADMISSION AND JOINING:

1. Candidates will be admitted to the respective Colleges as per their choice through online or personal appearance at the Counselling centre. Their declaration for choice of subject / college will be **firm & final** during that Counselling.
2. A candidate selected for admission in Govt. Medical Colleges, shall have to deposit the following fees payable at the time of admission.

3. The candidates seeking admission in HITECH Medical College & Hospital, Bhubaneswar, in the disciplines of Anatomy, Biochemistry & Pharmacology, are to pay a sum of ₹.4,50,000/- (Rupees four lacs & fifty thousand only) per annum with an additional amount of ₹.15,000/- towards admission process for General quota and ₹.5,00,000/- (Rupees five lacs only) per annum for management quota. Apart from these the optional costs as approved by Govt. are as under: (vide GO No. I-TTI-102/2011/ 9456 to 9458 Dt. 15.07.2011)

Note: The Fee structure for other disciplines can be obtained from College Authorities, after finalisation by Govt. and till then the present fees as above shall be applicable.

4. The courses of study and the registration of candidates for post-graduate study at the respective colleges in the subjects concerned will be regulated by the University to which the Medical College is affiliated.

5. The Medical Fitness Certificate must be produced by the candidate at the time of joining.
6. If any candidate does not join or leaves after joining the PG Course, due to which a seat goes lapsed, then the candidate concerned shall not be considered for selection in the next three academic sessions of the PG Course and the stipend/ salary already received by him/her will have to be refunded.

J. ATTENDANCE :

1. PG Students are to perform the duties as assigned to them by the Professor concerned and attend required theory and practical classes and departmental seminars regularly.
2. PG Students are entitled to avail 15 days leave during each year of study with the permission of the Head of the Institution, but such leave should not exceed 10 days at a stretch. This restriction does not hold good in case of candidates availing Maternity leave. The candidate has to repeat the exact number of days of leave taken in excess of 15 days after completion of the Course.
3. Absence beyond the total period of 15 days without prior permission of the Professor & Head of the concerned Department and Dean & Principal of the College concerned shall be seriously viewed and the candidate may forfeit the right to continue.
4. All candidates on joining the PG Course shall work full time during the period of training attending not less than 80% of the training during each calendar year. Private practice in any form is not allowed during the PG study. If such practice is detected, the candidature will be cancelled and legal action as deemed proper will be taken.

K. SALARY AND STIPEND:

1. PG Students admitted against direct quota seats will be paid stipend at rates prescribed by the Government of Odisha/ concerned Private Institutions from time to time subject to satisfactory performance of duties and maintenance of discipline and decorum.

2. Stipend/Leave Salary of in-service PG students under employment of Government of Odisha will be governed by the Resolution No.20385/H,Dt:05-07-1976 & No.38447/F, Dtd: 29-07-1980 and such other Government orders as may be issued from time to time.
3. The period of PG study of In-service category of candidates under regular employment of Government of Odisha (not on ad-hoc or contractual basis) admitted into PG Courses shall be governed as per the existing service rules and executive instructions thereon.
4. The candidates those who are coming from the Public Sector Undertakings as in-service candidates will get their salary from the respective Appointing Authorities.

L. HOSTEL (FOR GOVT. INSTITUTIONS ONLY):

1. Hostel accommodation being limited in all Colleges, cannot be guaranteed for all and allotment of seats in the Hostel will be made by the Dean & Principal of the concerned College to the needy and deserving students according to availability.
