5. ELIGIBILITY:

5.1 M.A./M.Sc. degree in Psychology from a University recognized by the U.G.C. **by cutoff day of 16.8.2013** with a minimum of 55% marks in aggregate, preferably with special paper in Clinical Psychology. For ST/SC category, minimum of 50% marks in aggregate is essential. Candidates with M.A. / M. Sc. Degree by correspondence Course / part time course / by distance education are not eligible.

5.2 The candidate has to be a permanent resident of Odisha.(**Appendix I**)

6. **APPLICATION FEES:** Fee of Rs. 1500/- (One thousand five hundred only) in shape of Bank Draft of State Bank of India, drawn in favor of **Convener, M. Phil Clinical Psychology Selection Committee(2013), payable at Cuttack**, is to be enclosed in original along with the application. The Bank Draft is not refundable under any circumstances.

7. DOCUMENTS TO BE ENCLOSED WITH THE APPLICATION FORM:

- a) Attested copy of resident/ nativity certificate from the competent authority issued not before than two years.
- b) Attested copies of certificates & mark sheets of H.S.C., +2, +3, M.A/ M. Sc. or equivalent examinations.
- c) Attested copy of conduct certificate from the institution last attended.
- d) Attested copy of certificate from competent authority in support of reservation category claimed.
- e) Two recent passport size photographs (one to be affixed in the application form and another in the Admit Card).
- f) One self-addressed envelope (25x 12 cms) with Rs.40/- postage stamp affixed.
- g) Copy of the intimation letter to the employer if applicable (vide Clause 16.6)

8. **SELECTION PROCEDURE:** The selection will be made strictly on merit determined by the marks obtained in written examination, interview and

practical. Written test will be of 90 marks consisting of 90 MCQ type Questions of M.A/ M.Sc. (Psychology) standard and of 60 minutes duration. Interview & practical will be of 10 marks. Applicants from Unreserved category will be called to appear in the interview and practical in the ratio of 1:3 and for reserved category the ratio will be 1:4.

Note - In case of tie the candidate securing more marks in the qualifying examination i.e. M.A./M.Sc. in Psychology will be ranked senior, and if still tie exist the candidate older in age will be ranked senior to younger.

- 10. HOSTEL** - Under construction and till completion of the hostel the candidates have to arrange their own accommodation.

12. RAGGING –

13. BOND AGREEMENT All the selected candidates will have to execute a **Bond Agreement** as per Govt. approved format with in 10 days of admission.

14. DISCONTINUATION OF STUDIES :-

14.1. Conditions for Leaving the Course

The trainee has to submit one month notice prior to discontinuation of the course and he/she will have to abide by the **Bond Agreement**.

14.2. Disqualification from Continuing the Course

The trainee will be declared disqualified from continuing the course under the following circumstances :

14.2.1 Any form of misconduct with any patient / faculty member / staff (if it is confirmed by the concerned disciplinary committee approved by the Director)

14.2.2. If disqualification is suggested by a disciplinary committee.

14.2.3. If the trainee does not appear in the examination for 3 consecutive times.

14.2.4. Submission of false documents or concealing related information.

14.2.5. If the trainee does not follow the rules and regulations of the Institute.

14.2.6. Trainee once expelled from the Institute will be disqualified to appear in any examination in M.H.I.in future.

14.2.7. If a trainee voluntarily withdraws from the course, he/she shall have to abide by the Bond Agreement & will not be allowed to continue the course further in future.

14.2.8. If a trainee is absent from the class/clinics without prior written information for more than one month, his/her name will be struck off from the rolls.

15. LEAVE MATTERS :-

15.1. All leaves must be pre-sanctioned by Dean & Principal, SCB Medical College, Cuttack.

15.2. Trainees must inform the respective departments & Unit consultants before availing leave.

15.3. Casual leave, maximum of 15 days per academic year, shall be permitted during the course period.

15.4. Sundays or other holidays falling in between the leave period will also be considered as leave.

16. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS :-

- 16.1 Incomplete applications will be rejected. Applications received after the closing date will not be considered.
- 16.2 No communication will be provided against the rejected applications.
- 16.3 Candidates are advised to send their applications by registered/speed post. Institute takes no responsibility for any delay in the receipt or loss of application in transit. Application submitted by any other means shall be rejected.
- 16.4 All declaration made in the application must be supported with documentary proof.
- 16.5 Candidates must bring all certificates in original on the day of written examination as well as on the day of interview for verification.
- 16.6 Employees of the State or Central Government or of any public sector undertaking should apply directly to the Convener with intimation to their employer. Copy of such intimation letter is to be attached along with the application form.
- 16.7 Candidates called for entrance examination have to make their own arrangements for stay. No TA/DA is admissible for this purpose.
- 16.8 The decision of Selection Committee shall be final in the matters of the selection of candidates.
- 16.9 The period of training is full-time and continuous. Candidates are strictly prohibited from undergoing any other part-time or correspondence course during the period of training.
- 16.10 Selected candidates shall have to submit the Migration Certificate and Transfer Certificate from the Board/University from which they have passed the last qualifying examination at the time of admission.

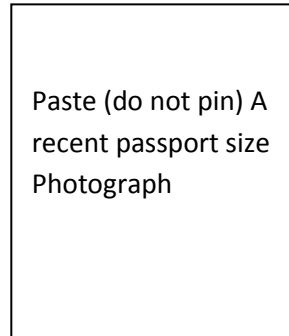

THE INSTITUTE & COURSE OVERVIEW

INTRODUCTION :

As Medical School from 1910 and Medical College from 1944, S.C.B. Medical College, Cuttack has undergone various transformations and progressed well to cater the needs of Odisha and adjacent states as a tertiary medical care institution.

Mental Health Institute (M.H.I.), S.C.B. Medical College and Hospital, Cuttack, earlier managed by Red Cross Society since 1961, was brought under the control of State Government from 01.04.1966. M.H.I. under the administrative control of Director Health Services, Odisha, and Department of Psychiatry which functions in M.H.I. under the administrative control of Director Medical Education and Training, Odisha led to functional inconvenience because of dual administration. Government after careful consideration have been pleased to decide to bring M.H.I. under the administrative control of Director, Medical Education And Training, Odisha (No. DC & MA (MH)-16/2012/34082/H. Dated 28.12.2012).

M.H.I., S.C.B. M.C.H, Cuttack has been upgraded to Centre of Excellence in Mental Health during 2010 under the National Mental Health Programme - Man power Development Scheme. Three new departments like Department of Clinical Psychology, Psychiatric Social Work and Psychiatric Nursing have been opened in addition to the existing department of Psychiatry in M.H.I. to create man-power in Mental Health. M.H.I. S.C.B. M.C.H, Cuttack, is the premier institute for the care of mentally ill over last five decades.

AIM & OBJECTIVES OF M. PHIL CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY COURSE

Aim

The aim of this course is to prepare the trainee to function as a qualified professional Clinical Psychologist in the areas of mental and physical health by offering Diagnostic, Therapeutic, Rehabilitative, Administrative services, and to work towards promoting the well-being and quality-of-life of individuals.

Objectives

The course is developed as a rigorous two-year program with extensive theoretical inputs and widespread clinical experience to acquire the necessary skills in the area of Clinical Psychology. On completion of the course, the trainee is expected to perform the following functions:

- a) Diagnose mental health problems.
- b) Conceptualize specific adult and child mental health problems within a psychological framework, giving due consideration to psychosocial/contextual factors, and carryout relevant treatment/management.
- c) Apply psychological principles and techniques in rehabilitating persons with mental health problems and disabilities.
- d) Work with the psychosocial dimensions of physical diseases, formulate and undertake focused/targeted psychosocial interventions.
- e) Work with community to promote health, quality-of-life and psycho-logical well-being.
- f) Undertake research in the areas of clinical psychology such as, mental health/illness, physical health/diseases and relevant societal issues viz. misconception, stigma, discrimination, social tension, gender con-struction, life style etc.
- g) Undertake responsibilities connected with teaching and training in core and allied areas of Clinical Psychology.
- h) Undertake administrative and supervisory/decision-making responsibilities in mental health area.
- i) Provide expert testimony in the court of law assuming different roles.
