NOTIFICATION

The 1<sup>st</sup> February 2006

No. 3163-DC & MA-CE5/2004-II.- The following draft of certain rules which the State Government propose to make in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 20 of the Orissa Clinical Establishments (Control and Regulation) Act, 1990 is hereby published as require by the said Section of the said Act for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said draft will be taken into consideration by the State Government on or after the expiry of a period of ninety days from the date of publication of this notification in the Official Gazette.

Any objection or suggestion which may be received from any person in respect of the said draft before the expiry of the period so specified above will be considered by the State Government.

1. (1) These rules, may be called the Orissa Clinical Establishment (Control and Regulation) Amendment Rules, 2006.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Orissa Gazette.

2. In Orissa Clinical Establishment (Control and Regulation) Rules, 1994 herein after referred to as the said rules), In Rule-3, (i) for sub-rule (2) the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely :-

(2) (i) The applications shall be accompanied by a receipt of Treasury Challan showing the payment of necessary fees mentioned against each of the categories of Private clinic/Nursing Homes as indicated in Table below towards grant / renewal of registration into the Government Treasury under the appropriate head of account as specified in Form-1.

(ii) The applicant while applying for renewal of registration shall apply not less than one month before the date on which the period of validity of the same is due to expire falling which 10% of the prescribed fees will be charged for every month of subsequently delay

And (ii) for sub-rule (5), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely :-  
 "(5) The supervising authority after due consideration of the application may grant registration, maintenance or renewal certificate in Form 2 or issue order of rejection with reasons within three months from the date of receipt of application :

Provided that all Clinical Establishments and Nursing Home shall possess clearance certificate from Orissa State Pollution Control Board for disposal of their Bio-Medical Waste under Bio-Medical Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 1998 prior to grant of registration / renewal certificate from the authority".

4. In the said rules, in Rule-4, the following provision to sub-rule (3) shall be inserted namely :-

"Provided that the District in which the number of Nursing Homes and Clinical Establishments is more than twenty, the Chief District Medical Officer may authorise ADMO (Medical) for inspection of the Nursing Homes / Clinical Establishments of that District".

5. In the said rules, in Form 1, for Item 6, the following provisions shall be substituted, namely :-

"A fee of Rs:10,000/-, Rs.8,000/-, Rs.6,000/-, Rs.5,000/- (as/per applicability) has been credited to Government under the Head of Account "0210-Medical & P.H. - 120- Receipt from Patients for Hospital and Dispensary Services - 9906480-Other Fees".
